Rewrite the sentences using the word given while keeping the meaning the same:

1. Wyoming is approximately as large as Colorado.

THAN

Colorado is not larger than Wyoming.

2. I find movies not nearly as interesting as books.

MUCH

I find books much more interesting than movies.

3. My math class is not as difficult as my physics class.

THE

My physics class is the more difficult class.

4. I think coffee is just as tasty as tea.

THAN

I don't think coffee is tastier than tea.

5. John is a better piano player than Ryan.

SUCH

Ryan is not such a good piano player as John.

6. Craig is much taller than David.

NEARLY

David isn't nearly as tall as Craig.

7. Peter speaks English just as poorly as Tom.

POOR

Tom's English is just as poor as Peter's.

8. My brother is not quite as lazy as I am.

BIT

I'm a bit lazier than my brother.

9. Munich is almost as expensive as Hamburg.

QUITE

Munich is not quite as expensive as Hamburg.

Translate:

1. Čím víc dostáváme, tím víc chceme.

The more we get, the more we want.

2. Čím lepší práci máš, tím méně se strachuješ o budoucnost.

The better job you have, the less you worry about the future.

3. Do Ostravy je to méně než 50 km.

It's less than 50 kilometers to Ostrava.

4. Bylo tam méně lidí, než jsme čekali.

There were fewer people there than we expected.

5. New York je odsud mnohem dál než Praha.

New York is much farther from here than Prague.

6. Naše vlasy jsou úplně stejné.

Our hair is exactly the same.

7. To není pravda, tvoje vlasy nejsou zdaleka tak dlouhé jako moje.

That's not true, your hair isn't nearly as long as mine.

8. Která z těch dvou knih je ta složitější?

Which of the two books is the more complex one?
