


#### Some facts about our country

- The highest peak is Sněžka 1,602 metres (5,256 ft)
- The national park the Krkonoše NP
- The River Elbe rises within the Giant Mountains

- Activities downhill and cross-country skiing, hiking, cycling

## Lesser Town










### Jewish Quarter
