b) $y = \frac{3x+5}{\ln x}$

c) $y = \ln(x^2 + 2x - 1)$

$f(x) = \ln(x^2 - 36)$

3) Find Taylor series of $f(x) = 4x^3 + 2x^2 - 5x + 1$ at the point $a = 2$.

4) Find maxima/minima of the function: $y = x^3 - 12x + 4$.

5) Find the increment (find total differential) of the function

$f(x) = 3x + 2x^2$ for $x = 1$, $dx = 0.1$
